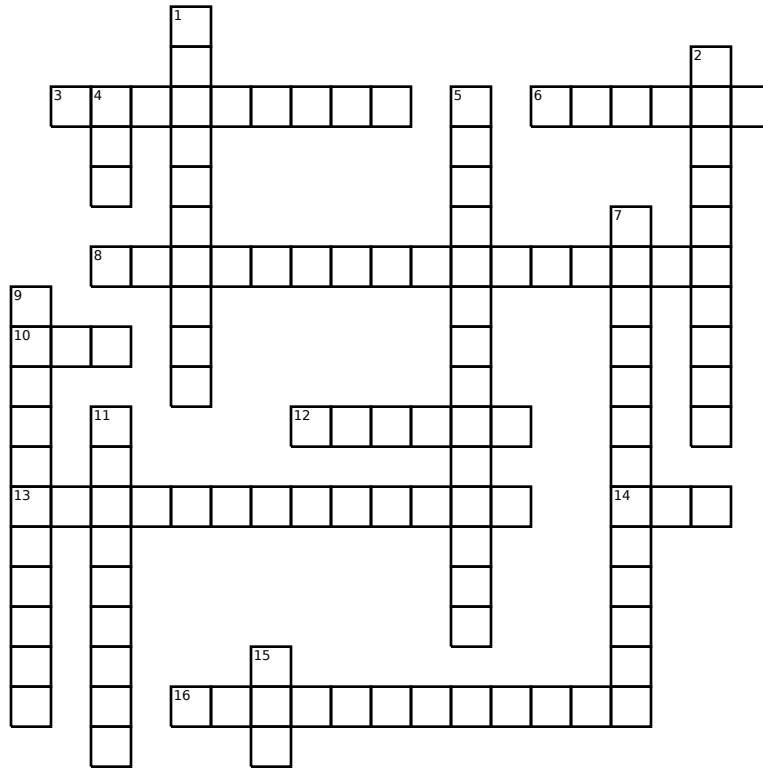


# Circle City Arts & Culture Scene
